FAQ about the Walking School Bus

- Q. What should I do if my child is ill?
- A. If your child is ill, the bus will travel normally and not wait for passengers that are not at their designated stop on time.
- Q. What happens with the bus in the wet weather?
- A. The philosophy of the bus is to walk rain, hail or shine.
 Make sure your child is suitably dressed for the weather
 including an umbrella or raincoat & sunscreen.
- Q. What if I need to change or cancel my child's use of the Walking School Bus?
- A. Please advise any changes to your child's usage of the walking school bus to a walking school bus volunteer.
- Q. What is my role as an adult?
- A. Complete the enrolment and consent forms.
- B. Ensure that your child arrives at their designated bus stop in the morning & that you or a designated person are at the bus stop at the correct pick up time in the afternoon.
- Q. How will you incorporate road safety with my child?
- A. Volunteers have been trained in road safety & will model appropriate road safety behavior.
- B. All children will wear safety vests on the walking school bus to ensure visibility.
- C. Children are encouraged to "**Stop, Look, Listen & Think"** before they cross the road.

- ♦ Stop One– Grassed area– King Street opposite the station.
- Concludes (morning)- Victoria Avenue Community precinct main entrance (side entry).

Route 2- George St


- Meeting Point– Grassed area, eastern side– Corner of Pomeroy & George Street
- Stop One– George Street opposite Mena Street.
- ♦ Stop Two- George Street opposite Rothwell Street,
- ♦ Concludes (morning)- Victoria Avenue Community precinct main entrance (side entry).
